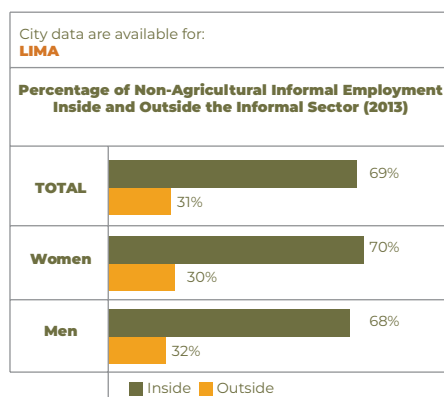

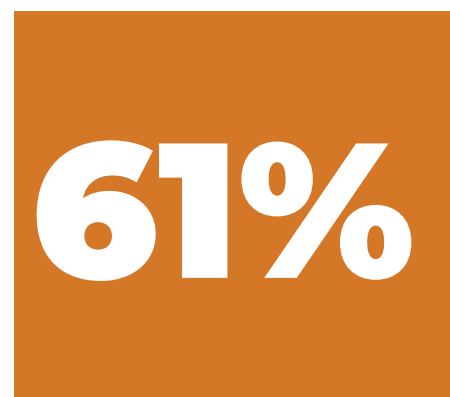

- Influence frameworks



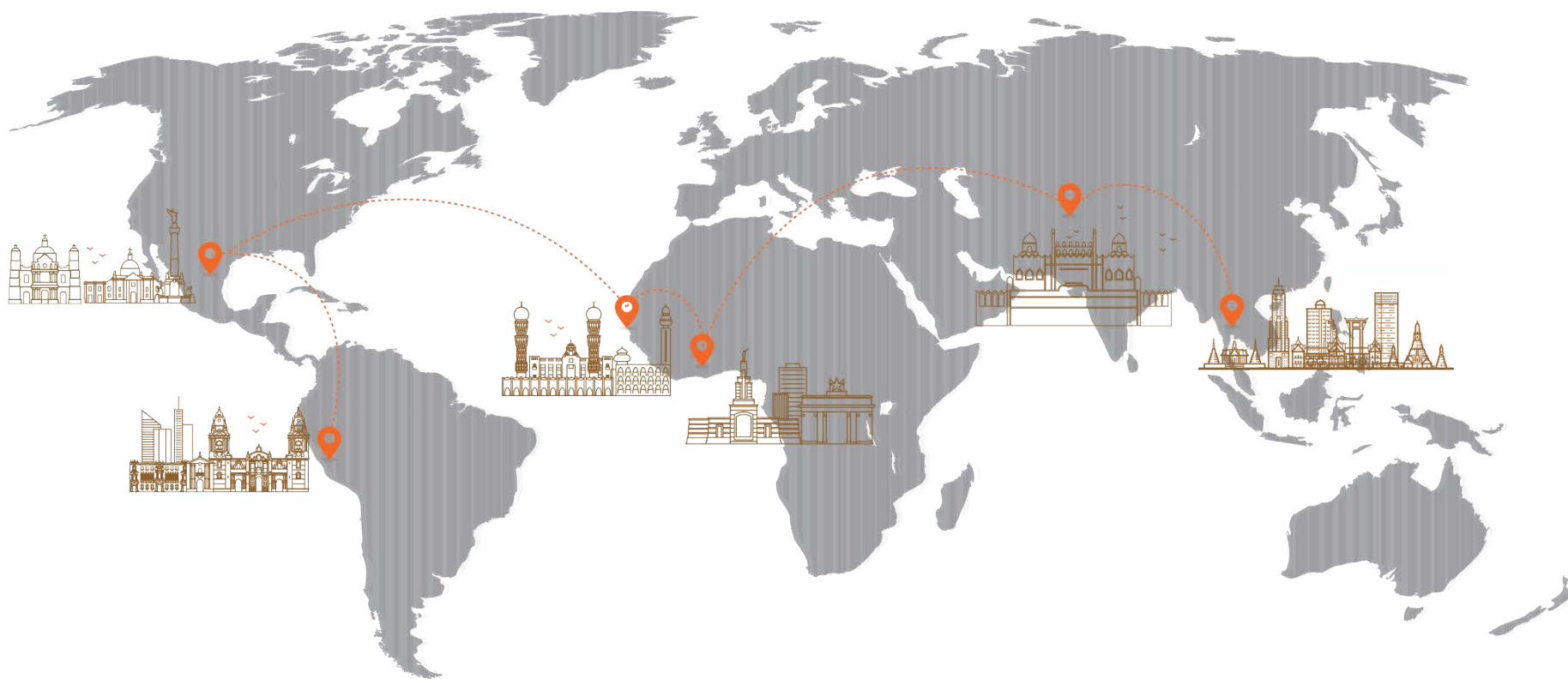
1. Shaped the New Urban Agenda

- **Accra:** Abolished unfair toll
- **Bangkok:** Supported founding of new cross-sector federation
- **Dakar:** Supported organizational development
- **Delhi:** Convened solid waste roundtable
- **Lima:** Developed multiple election platforms
- **Mexico City:** Built cross-sector platform
